

# Instructions on retraction or correction of the articles of the scientific journal "Bulletin of Dulaty University"

**Retractioning a text from a publication** is a mechanism for correcting published information and notifying readers that a publication contains serious flaws or erroneous data that cannot be trusted.

# The grounds for retraction (withdrawal) of the article are:



Detection of plagiarism



Duplication of an article, in several editions



Detection in the article of fabrication, falsification data



Detection of serious errors in the article that cast doubt on its scientific value



Incorrect composition of authors



The conflict of interests of the authors and reviewers is hidden



Republishing an article without the consent of the authors



The article did not go through the peer review procedure



Other violations of the ethical principles

# The procedure for the withdrawal (retraction) of an article in the journals



After the appeal of the author or another person who provided facts of violations of scientific ethics in the article, the editorial board of the journal appoints a commission that conducts a comprehensive study of the case, taking into account all available facts and opportunities to verify the ethics of the publication.



Having decided to withdraw the article, the editorial board indicates in the minutes of the meeting the reason for the retraction (in case of plagiarism, indicating the sources of borrowing), as well as the date of the retraction.



If the commission finds that a small part of the article is incorrect (with the overall quality), the corrected article will be republished with a special mark in the next edition after the commission meeting.



The editorial board reserves the right to make its own decision regarding further cooperation with the authors of the retracted articles.
